The Real Ale festivals on the South Devon Railway from the Devon Diesel Society generate funds for the ongoing restoration of their collection of heritage diesel locomotives, Class 04 D2246, Class 37 D6737 and Class 50 D402.

The festivals are held at the idyllic Staverton station and feature 50+ ales and traditional ciders, all served at great prices and from the new bar in the goods shed.

Frequent train services, including late trains on most days, run to and from the festivals from both Buckfastleigh (large free car park) and Totnes (main line connections).
