- The date of the walk is Saturday 16 July 2016.
- Walk is along the track of the South Devon Railway, between Totnes Littlehempston stations and Buckfastleigh. Please use suitable footwear and clothing. Bring water with you.
- Trains will not be running for the duration of the walk.
- Walkers may catch the 3.45pm train from Buckfastleigh to Totnes to start the walk. Normal fares payable.
- Please get your form stamped on return to Buckfastleigh, to show that you have completed the walk.
- A free barbecue is available for all walkers on return to Buckfastleigh.
- Please get as many sponsors as possible. Please pay in all money to the "SDR Museum Group" as soon as possible after the event, and in any case not later than 31 August 2016. SDRT Museum Support Group will keep a full account of all monies received, and will apportion them equally with Buckfastleigh Station Group.

Please be aware that there is no access to the railway between Totnes and Buckfastleigh, except at Nappers Crossing and Staverton station. The mobile phone signal is also poor to non-existent for most of the way.
