Even if you can only commit to a few hours a week, you would be very welcome. All that we ask is that you become a member of the South Devon Railway Association, that you are reasonably fit for the duties to be undertaken and take part in our induction programme, which includes safety training.



HOW CAN I HELP?

We have many departments on the railway where you can assist. Amongst these are:

STATION and MUSEUM STAFF Booking Office Clerks, Porters and Station Staff are always welcome at Buckfastleigh, Staverton and Totnes Littlehempston. Museum Stewards and Tour Guides are also welcome at Buckfastleigh.

CARRIAGE AND WAGON Help with the maintenance and restoration of our fleet of heritage carriages and wagons.

CATERING Run our "Buffet cars", or serve on our prestigious "Devonshire Pullman" dining trains.

SIGNAL AND TELEGRAPH Train to become a signaller in one of our 3 signal boxes or help maintain our lineside equipment.

CIVIL ENGINEERING Help maintain our buildings, platforms, bridges, line side fencing and drains.

PERMANENT WAY Help maintain our 7 miles of track. As a starter, join our Wednesday Cutting Back Gang.

LOCOMOTIVE RESTORATION Our fully equipped workshop tackles everything from tyre fitting to complete overhauls.

STATION SHOP & CAFÉ Counter staff, serving and table staff required all year round.

OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT Locomotive Crews, Guards, Ticket Inspectors (Training, Medical and Rules Exams required).

OTHER DUTIES We always welcome people to help with our miniature railway, special events, administration, finance, gardening, fund raising, even answering telephone enquiries.
