Following the success of the 2012 festivals, and after several requests to stage one, the Society will be pleased to welcome you to its first ever Winter Ale festival, which will be held over two weekends in February. The festival will be held in the Society's purpose built bar and waiting room at Staverton station and will be open at the following times:

Saturday 16th February	11.00 until 23.00
Sunday 17th February	11.00 until 22.30 (Quiz Night - starts at 19.15)
Saturday 23rd February	11.00 until 23.00
Sunday 24th February	11.00 until 18.00

A fine selection of ales, plus a couple of ciders, will be on sale at just £2.80 per pint, with proceeds from the event going towards the ongoing restoration and return to service of the Society's 117ton English Electric Type 4 number D402.

Special train services operate on all four days as part of the South Devon Railway's Winter Branch Line Gala, with late trains on Saturday 16th, Sunday 17th & Saturday 23rd. The Gala features the special guest appearance (courtesy of the Great Western Society) of the unique Steam Railmotor No.93, along with a variety of "Auto Trains" worked by visiting locomotives No's. 1450 & 5542. Also in use will be home based pannier tank 1369, together with pioneer Class 122 diesel railcar No. W55000.
